Current Programs



We are harnessing the power of the Internet to reunite lost pets with their owners. This unique service is a free "Amber Alert for pets" that uses Facebook and Twitter to quickly broadcast information about pets separated from their owners. We've already helped many dogs and cats find their way back home.



A loved pet should never lose his or her home just because money is tight. The Pet Pantry provides pet food and supplies to families experiencing financial difficulties, keeping loved ones together while reducing the number of animals surrendered to shelters.

Future Programs

Direct Care:

Spay and neuter the pets of low-income families for little or no cost.

Trap, spay or neuter, and release feral cats.

Train shelter dogs and cats to serve as therapy animals.

Operate a no-kill animal sanctuary.

Education:

Share information and resources with the community.

Create classroom and community outreach programs to educate children and adults about the importance of compassion for animals and how to properly care for a pet.

Work with landlords to keep pets in their homes and encourage pet-friendly housing.

Emergency Services:

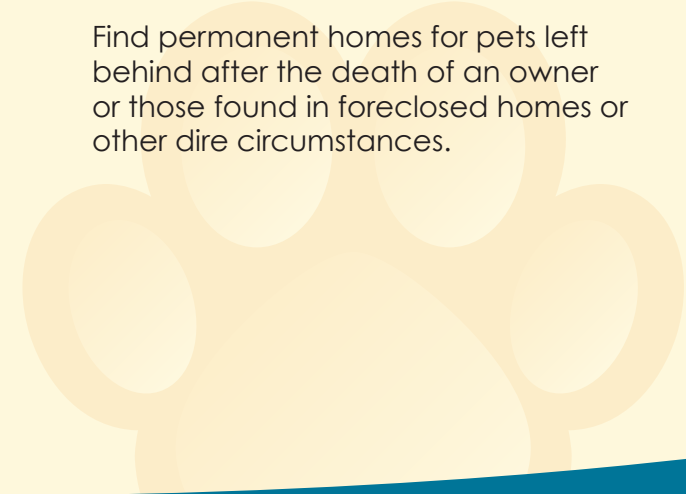
Offer food, supplies, and medical care to pets of the homeless.

Fostering/Placement:

Offer temporary housing for pets of battered women, deployed military, and the homeless seeking refuge or medical care.

Create and maintain a database of foster homes for area rescue groups.
